



## Frequently Asked Questions

### **Q1. What is MILLIONAIRE FOR LIFE™?**

A. MILLIONAIRE FOR LIFE is an exciting new daily draw game from the Maine Lottery offering a chance to win the top prize of \$1 Million each year for the rest of your life and the chance to win the second prize of \$100,000 a year for life!

### **Q2. Is this a new game? Is this a new version of Lucky for Life?**

A. MILLIONAIRE FOR LIFE is a new game introduced on February 22, 2026. Lucky for Life ended when this game started.

### **Q3. Is MILLIONAIRE FOR LIFE a Maine-only game?**

A. No, MILLIONAIRE FOR LIFE is being offered to players in many states across the country, similar to Powerball or Mega Millions. The chances of winning are the same no matter where you play.

### **Q4. What is the Top Prize?**

A. \$1 million each year for life!

### **Q5. Are there other prizes?**

A. Yes, besides the top prize, there is a second prize of \$100,000 each year for life. Plus, a range of prizes as follows:

### **Q6. What if more than one person matches the numbers for the top prize?**

A. The Top Prize will be determined on a pari-mutuel basis (which means the prize amount is divided between the number of winners). In certain circumstances, the Second Prize of \$100,000 each year for life, may become pari-mutuel. The seven lower prize tiers are set cash prizes.

### **Q7. Is there a cash option for the top prize instead of yearly payments?**

A. Yes, the Cash Option for the Top Prize is \$18,000,000 and the Cash Option for the second prize is \$2,200,000.

### **Q8. How much does it cost to play?**

A. The cost is \$5 per play.

### **Q9. How do you play MILLIONAIRE FOR LIFE?**

A. To play, you must simply select a total of 6 numbers: 5 numbers from 1 through 58 and 1 number from 1 through 5 for the Millionaire Ball.

### **Q10. How do I select numbers?**

- You can choose your own numbers or let the terminal pick your numbers for you.
- You can use a Millionaire for Life Play Slip to pick your numbers – just complete it and give it to the retailer at check out.
- You can ask a retail clerk for E-Z Pick and let the terminal provide a randomly generated set of numbers.
- You can create an E-Play Slip on the Maine Lottery's RewardME App and have the retailer scan the bar code.



## Frequently Asked Questions

### **Q11. Where can I get a MILLIONAIRE FOR LIFE ticket?**

A. You can purchase a ticket from any Maine Lottery retailer, or from a Maine Lottery self-service vending machine.

### **Q12. Is there a deadline to buy my ticket?**

A. Yes, tickets may be purchased up to 10:15pm daily, 1 hour in advance of the drawings.

### **Q13. When are the drawings?**

A. Drawings are every day, 7 days a week, at approximately 11:15pm.

### **Q14. Where can I find the winning numbers drawn?**

A. The winning numbers can be found online at [mainelottery.com](http://mainelottery.com), on the Maine Lottery's RewardME App or any Maine Lottery retailer.

### **Q15. Can I see the winning numbers of previous drawings?**

A. Yes, these are available at [mainelottery.com](http://mainelottery.com).

### **Q16. How do I know if my ticket is a winner?**

A. You can check the winning numbers against the numbers on your ticket by visiting [mainelottery.com](http://mainelottery.com) or you can scan your ticket at any Maine Lottery retailer, or on the Maine Lottery's Reward ME app, or at any Maine Lottery self-service vending machine.

### **Q17. Can I play more than one set of numbers at a time?**

A. Yes, you can play multiple sets of numbers at one time. Plus, you can play the same set of numbers for up to 30 consecutive drawings. Just ask your Maine Lottery retailer, fill out a Play Slip, use the Lottery Self-Service Terminal or create an E-Play Slip using the Lottery's RewardME App.

### **Q18. Can I cancel a play or cancel a ticket?**

A. No, once a ticket is printed it cannot be cancelled.

### **Q19. Who can play MILLIONAIRE FOR LIFE?**

A. Any person 18 years of age or older may purchase a ticket.

### **Q20. Can I purchase a MILLIONAIRE FOR LIFE ticket online?**

A. No, the Maine Lottery does not sell tickets online.

### **Q21. Can I purchase a ticket in Maine if I am not a Maine resident?**

A. Yes, you must be physically located in Maine and be at least 18 years of age or older.

### **Q22. What do I do if I win?**

A. Congratulations! Sign the back of your ticket. Lottery tickets are bearer instruments. Unless signed, anyone in possession of a ticket can file a claim. Then, store the ticket in a safe place until you are ready to collect your winnings.

### **Q23. Where can I collect my prize?**

A. For prizes up to \$599, you can request payment of your prize from any Maine Lottery Retailer. For prizes \$600 or more, you can collect your prize at the Maine Lottery office at 19 Union Street, 3rd Floor, Augusta, Maine, during office hours. ### **Q24. How long do I have to claim my prize?**

A. All MILLIONAIRE FOR LIFE prizes must be claimed within 365 calendar days from the drawing in which the prize was won.
